SAN SALVADOR RAINFOREST ZIPLINING & RAPPELLING ★

Full day \$139.00 pp, moderate-challenging. (Duration time: 6-7 hrs.) Includes transportation, equipment, fresh fruit, tropical juice, water and a complete puertorrican meal. (Required age: 12 yrs or older. Required weight: 250 lbs or less)

Escape the crowds of the mainland and get ready to get wet in this hidden treasure that is just 40 minutes away from the metro area. We'll explore, trek and climb through cascading clear waterfalls and abundant prismatically colored flora and rocks found in the San Salvador rainforest, located in the beautiful countryside of Caguas. Our knowledgeable tour guides will enlighten us on the ecology, history and culture of this dramatic region that was once populated by the Taino indians. This exciting experience includes over 400 ft. long ziplines across stunning canyons, waterfalls, rivers and through the trees. Rappelling into a 80 ft. long waterfall, belaying over rocks and staircasing up the river add to this trip's appeal. At the end of the adventure you will enjoy a delicious and typical puertorrican meal in a local restaurant which includes roasted pig or chicken, rice and beans, viands and other delicacies.

SEVEN SEAS DRY FOREST & BIOLUMINESCENT BAY KAYAKING

Full day, \$129.00 pp*, moderate. (Duration time: 8 hrs.) Includes transportation, snacks and lunch.

Get ready for an unforgettable afternoon and night of fun. We start off hiking through Seven Seas Natural Reserve in Fajardo which includes one of Puerto Rico's pristine beaches complete with boulders, cliffs and lava formations. Here you will see a variety of birds and sights of unequal color and splendor. We'll enjoy a relaxing walk through the amazing red mangrove trail which takes us to the breathtaking Convento and Red Beaches from where you will admire Fajardo's 19th century lighthouse. After a nutritious snack we'll paddle at night to see one of nature's amazing wonders, the Bioluminescent Bay. You'll be amazed by the glowing water as you paddle in a 2-person kayak among the fluorescent plankton. This is an amazing experience!

EL YUNQUE RAINFOREST HIKE

- Half day, \$57.00 pp, easy. (Duration time: 5-6 hrs.)
- Full day, \$72.00 pp, moderate. (Duration time: 7-8 hrs.)

Discover the wonders of the El Yunque Rainforest with our experienced guides. Currently managed by the United States Forest Service, the Forest counts with over 28,000 contiguous acres within the Sierra de Luquillo. With peaks, escarpments, myriad streams and waterfalls, and a lush green vegetation representing various forest types, the El Yunque is truly a scenic paradise. It is also a naturalist's delight, with a diverse native flora and fauna which includes many species found anywhere else on the planet. It is home to over 1,000 species of plants, over 30 species of amphibians and reptiles, 11 species of bats, and 68 species of birds, including the endangered Puerto Rican parrot. To enjoy this reserve the Forest Service maintains 13 marked trails representing various levels of difficulty. Our visits to the forest concentrate on hiking with the option of a refreshing swim in one of the many natural pools and waterfalls. Whether on a half day or a full day visit we are sure you will appreciate why El Yunque is one of our great national treasures.

HUMACAO RESERVE NATURE ADVENTURE

Full day, \$129.00 pp*, moderate. (Duration time: 6 hrs.) Includes transportation, kayak rental, snacks and lunch.

Discover one of Puerto Rico's untouched natural treasures. We begin our day with a relaxing walk through an old coconut and sugar cane plantation dating back to the 19th century. Our hike takes us through the beautiful sights and sounds of the many species of beautiful birds, harmless reptiles and bountiful fish. Along the way you will be astounded by the breathtaking views of the pristine sandy beaches and the nearby islands. We will also explore bunkers and barracks dating back to World War II. After a light lunch our tour continues paddling in kayaks through an amazing white mangrove in the lagoon which used to be an ancient sugar cane field. In this unforgettable kayak trip you will admire the views of El Yunque Rainforest and the wide variety of flora and fauna that make this natural reserve unique. This adventure is a naturalists must do.

BIOLUMINESCENT BAY KAYAKING

\$85.00 pp, easy. (Duration time: 4 hrs.) Includes transportation, kayak rental fees and snacks. (Combined with El Yunque Rainforest and Luquillo Beach: \$145.00 pp)

Join us to experience one of nature's amazing wonders. We will paddle in a two-person kayak at night to the Bioluminescent Bay in Fajardo where we will admire the fluorescent microorganisms. Our friendly and bilingual tour guides will enlighten you with the flora and fauna of this natural reserve. Feel free to stir the water with your hands and legs and watch the amazing plankton glow. There are only five places in the world that have this phenomenon and Puerto Rico has three of them.

PIÑONES LAGOON KAYAKING

\$69.00 pp*, easy. (Duration time: 2-3 hrs.) Includes transportation, kayak rental fees and snacks.

Relax and enjoy yourself seeing the abundant wildlife while kayaking through the lush red mangrove trees, beautiful lagoons and tranquil waters of the Piñones Forest Natural Reserve. This piece of paradise is home to hundreds of water birds, iguanas and many fish species. This tour is only a 10 minute drive from the Isla Verde area. We will begin with a chat about the forest's history and interesting facts about its flora and fauna. Here you will appreciate the sights of a local fishing village, El Yunque Rainforest mountain outline and the natural beauty and sounds that will surround you. Afterwards you will be delighted with a tasty local creole food and fresh coconut water. This tour is the perfect activity for those who are pressed for time or are looking for an easy and leisurely tour.
